

# La Plume Township

## REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

February 13, 2025

The La Plume Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on the above date and was called to order by Vice Chair Gerry Henry. Also present were Supervisor Jeremy Wohlken, Roadmaster Bruce VanFleet and Engineer John Seamans. The minutes of the previous meeting were approved in a motion made by Gerry Henry and seconded by Jeremy Wohlken.

Payment of the monthly bills was approved, motion by Jeremy Wohlken, seconded by Gerry Henry. Treasurer's Report was reviewed and will be filed. Both are attached below.

### **Roadmasters Report**

Roadmaster Bruce VanFleet gave an overview of his activity in the township. He salted Maple Road where runoff water is collecting and freezing. He met with 811 representative Maria White, attended the PUC hearing on 2/11 and spoke with a representative from PPL about tree trimming along the road right of way.

### **Engineer's Report**

Township engineer John Seamans informed the board that it is likely La Plume will be receiving the applied for Dirt and Gravel Road/Low Volume Road Grant that was applied for. No set date was given for the award, but plans should start to be made to complete that work. He also worked with Lou LaFratte at the request of the supervisors to complete audit paperwork requested by FEMA.

### **Zoning Officer's Report**

Zoning officer Anthony Mengoni provided the supervisors with a report of his activity over the last month in advance of the meeting. 2096 East La Plume Road has a magistrate hearing scheduled for 3/13/2025.

### **Unfinished Business.**

A representative from Keystone College was not in attendance at the meeting.

Bruce VanFleet & Jeremy Wohlken attended a hearing with the PUC on 2/11 regarding PA One Call violations. No financial penalties were issues and arrangements will be made to meet the educational requirements.

### **New Business**

A motion was made by Gerry Henry, seconded by Jeremy Wohlken to appoint Joanne Klingel as delegate for the TCC.

Secretary Melissa Scott will be contacting Lou LaFratte, the township flood plain administrator to ensure that the mandatory FEMA audit is completed.
